<u>VITALITY</u>

Vitality, in my interpretation, symbolizes the ability to adapt, utilize, and survive. To create life, to foster growth. It is fragile, strong, and beautiful.

TL's notion of how inextricably life and death are interwoven, along with reflections on the transience of all things, makes it all the more important to seize the fleeting "Now" and give it substance. Life is life, regardless of its form or kind. The cuckoo chick can fend for itself — and that is a beauty in itself.

VENUS

I have interpreted the work *Venus* in its earthly manifestation — VENUS young and seductive. Although TL observed the planet Venus with enthusiasm, woman was for him the grand symbol of the "*Now*" in all its splendor and glory — where the girl, who daringly sheds her garments, becomes the very embodiment of "*Now*," her lush body's vitality identical with growth — the inherent, procreative drive toward the future, helping to shape humanity and give the "*Now*" its fullness. A higher revelation the "*Now*" could not attain, for him (TL).

Aries, despite its brave, energetic, and powerful nature and appearance, is (as a zodiac sign) also an incurable romantic.

Aries was TL's own zodiac sign. What is essential to TL, and makes him such a complex person, is a tension between a romantic mind and a thoroughly naturalistic intellect. He is sensual and erotically inclined. He holds a belief in life's deep creative forces.

This work is interpreted through the concept of *Fertility and Fruitfulness*, while also being inspired by TL's meditations and relationship to Norse mythology.
